

MD Angels Presentation Guidelines

Welcome

We are delighted that you will be presenting at our next meeting, and we are looking forward to hearing more about your company and the investment opportunity. The following guidelines are intended to help ensure a successful event for you and our community of investors. Our membership community is varied, but primarily comprised of doctors and other professionals with life science backgrounds and experience. Hence, your presentation can include more technical information than what you might present at other forums. We are, however, seeking to obtain a complete picture of the opportunity including business fundamentals and market assessments for your product or service.

Our guidelines and recommendations presented here are not requirements, and you are free to determine the order and content of your presentation.

Meeting Format

- Total time 25 minutes per company
 - Presentation 10 to 15 minutes
 - Group Q&A 10 minutes
- Networking opportunity
 - 20-30 minutes before presentations begin
 - 10-15 minutes after all companies present
- Following networking, all companies and non-sponsored guests will be asked to depart the room and are free to leave.
- Members will then spend time that evening discussing all presenting companies. You can expect to receive feedback and next steps within 1 week of presentation date.

Presentation Guidelines

Our guidance for the content of your presentation is discussed above. It is very important to us that you tell a comprehensive and comprehensible story of your company. Under the “Apply For Funding” link on our website (mdangels.net), you will find a worksheet of questions that you will need to complete and submit to us prior to the presentation date. In addition, you will need to email us the PowerPoint of your presentation and an executive summary. A member of our team will work with you to make sure that we have all the information and documents needed prior to your presentation date. These documents will be distributed to all members in attendance of the meeting. The due diligence questions must be answered completely for us to gain a better understanding of your company. We appreciate that some of this information will also be covered in your presentation, but again, we urge you to tell your story during the 10-15 minutes that you have to present.
